Standard 1: Well-designed outdoor space

Principle 4: Identify each area with a sign or other visual clues.

Principle 5: Be sure every area is visible at all times.

Principle 6: Use a variety of natural materials, including trees and other live plants.

Principle 7: Choose elements for durability and low maintenance.

Principle 8: Maximize beauty and visual clarity in the over-all design.

Principle 9: Personalize the design with regional materials, and ideas from children and staff.

Principle 10: Be sure the space continues to meet all regulatory standards for your region.
